**Introduction :**

**Side :** little larger

**User :** mixed

**Needle :** : 3,5 – 4 (mm)

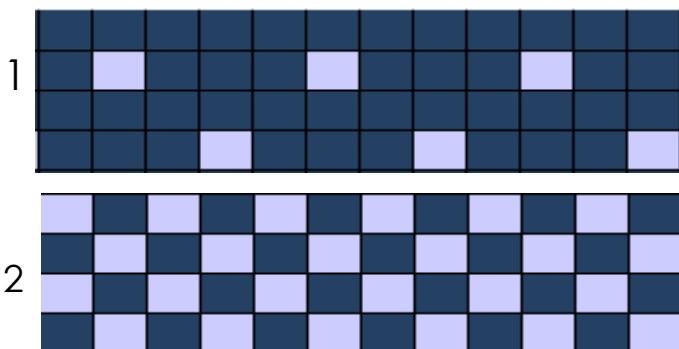
**Yarn :** Bouclélaïne  
« mérinos angora 20 » color Véronique  
et Loup

**Yardage :** Véronique : 120m

Loup (+pompom) : 130m

**Gauge :** 25m / 32rg

**Abbreviation and technical at the end**



**Decrease :**

Follow the diagram n°2

**All rows P are knitting normally**

Rep from \* to \* 7 time :

Row K:

K1. - *K16 - K3tog*	- 1m lis.	= 107
" - *K15 - K3tog*	"	= 93
" - *K14 - K3tog*	"	= 79
" - *K13 - K3tog*	"	= 65
" - " - "	"	= ...

*Rep. decrease until have more than 20 on the needle*



**Explications :**

1. CO **113m**
2. knit **3,5cm** in brioche stitch
3. knit 2rows in st st blue
4. K1. - \*4K1 –kfb, k1 fb\* - K1. Rep from \* to \* 27.
5. knit 2rows in st st blue
6. knit 12,5cm in st st n°1
7. knit 5rows st st blue



Cut the thread and sew in invisible stitching (see technical particular)

If you wish, you can add a pompom (as on the model of origin)

CO : cast on

K1 :

P : purl

Rep : repeat

Dec : decrease

K3tog : Knit 3 stitches together

St st : Stockinette stitch
